About the College

Late Laxmibai Deshmukh Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Parli Vaijnath affiliated to Dr Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar and is accredited by NAAC with B grade in the first cycle and second cycle. Being a women's educational institute, functioning under the management Late Laxmibai Deshmukh Shikshan Prasarak Mandal. The college contributes immensely to the welfare of women, although they contribute 50% of the total population, they are marginalized and under privileged section of the society.

The college started functioning on 01/07/1997 with three branches, Arts, Science and Commerce each for degree classes. The institution was raised to the status of a degree college in 2000. At present, the institution has a strength of around 700 students, 23 teachers (Including the principal), 19 departments and courses in Arts, Science and Commerce. The institution offers programmes in English, Hindi, Marathi, Sanskrit, History, Political science, Sociology, Public Administration, Geography, Economics, Home Science and Music in Arts faculty; and Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology and Computer Science in Science faculty.

Our college is also recognized as study center of Yashwantrao Chavan Maharashtra Open University, Nashik to offer UG programmes through distance mode.
